

Minor/Miner WINN -

Minor WINN - Husband of Nancy WILSON - Father to Dennis Wilson WINN

Taken from Desert News - Reported on the 19th day of Feb 1877.

Died - Richfield, Sevier, Utah on Feb, 1877, with Lung complication.

Born - Pendleton District, South Carolina 1798. (At the time of Minor's birth, Pendleton District was also referred to as "Old 96" and also as Abbeville District. The Place of birth for the children of Minor and Rachel shows Ninety Six, Greenwood, S.C. Greenwood was not formed until 1897, which was almost 100 years after the birth of the children of Minor and Rachel Winn. At the time of birth of Dennis Winn, abt 1797, the area known as Greenwood was Abbeville and Edgefield, both formed in 1785 from District 96.)

Baptized - June 1835 by George P. Dykes

Minor joined the Village Creek Branch of the LDS Church in Edwards County, Illinois. In 1837 he went with Bro. Andrew Hamilton to Adams County and there remained till he gathered with the Saints to Nauvoo and continued working on the Temple and Helping to guard the Prophet Joseph when exposed to mob violence, until driven away at the general expulsion of the Saints from their homes.

He crossed the plains in _____; was ordained a High Priest in Cache County in 1868. He moved to Parowan, subsequently to Beaver County, and in the fall of 1876 he came to Richfield purposely to become identified with the United Order in which he was a firm believer to his last breath.

He Leaves (5) living children, (67) grand children, and (24) great grand children to mourn his loss.

He died in full faith of a Glorious Resurrection.
