

THE HAMPTON FAMILY OF SOUTH CAROLINA

One of the families usually associated with the Up-Country of South Carolina is Hampton. The following is a brief genealogical survey of this family, with emphasis on some of the interesting branches and connections, and mentioning a few present-day descendants.

The first of the Hampton family in the New World is said by some to have been William Hampton who came to Virginia in 1620; others contend it was Thomas Hampton, an Episcopal clergyman who arrived in Virginia about 1630. Since many of the early records have been lost, this puzzle may never be solved; however, it is agreed that they came from a family of country gentry established in England by the fourth century.

We do have some records of the first generations in Virginia; we know that there was a second Thomas Hampton, also an Episcopal clergyman with a parish in James City County, and that among his children was Capt. John Hampton. John's first wife was Mary Mann, niece of John Mann of Gloucester County, Va. Their son, also named John, was married to Margaret Wade of New Kent County, Va., but this was not the first time the names Wade and Hampton had been united, for John's aunt had also married a Wade and among her descendants was Hampton Wade who lived in Lunenburg County, Va. shortly before the Revolution.

John and Margaret Wade Hampton had a number of children, most of whom continued to live in Virginia, although their descendants now are scattered throughout the country. Two of their children, however, moved to South Carolina--their daughter Rosamond married William Winn of Fauquier County, Va. and moved to South Carolina with him and his brothers before the Revolution, where they founded the town of Winnsboro; and their son Anthony, after several moves in Virginia and North Carolina, came to South Carolina in 1774. He married in Virginia to Elizabeth Ann Preston, the first in a number of alliances with that family.

Anthony and Elizabeth Hampton, with their six sons, a daughter and her husband, settled on the western frontier of the state, near the present town of Greer and very near the dividing line between 96 District and the Cherokee Indian Nation. As war with England approached, the colonists tried to make the Indians their allies or at least to insure their neutrality, but the British seem to have been more successful and in one of the ensuing Indian raids Anthony Hampton was massacred along with his wife, son Preston, and infant grandson. The other five sons all took an active part in the Revolution. Edward was a captain and was killed in one of "Bloody Bill" Cunningham's raids; his son Noah was killed in the battle of Earle's Ford. John served in the French and Indian War as well as the Revolution, was elected to the S.C. House of Representatives and Senate, and held a number of other offices. Richard and Henry were both Revolutionary colonels, Henry moving to Mississippi afterwards.

Wade Hampton I was the most famous of Anthony Hampton's sons and it was with him that the fortunes of the family rose in this state. He had a successful career in the Revolution, becoming one of Sumter's most capable cavalry officers, and after the war settled in Richland District where he bought a large tract of land near the future city of Columbia. He was the first to plant cotton in Richland District and the first in the state to employ a cotton gin run on water power. For many years he was one of the most extensive planters in the country, expanding into sugar production with a large Louisiana plantation. He was twice a member of Congress and held a number of other public offices. When the War of 1812 threatened he resumed his military career and rose to the rank of major general, resigning at the age of 62. Wade Hampton I was married three times, and according to Professor J. H. Easterby, "wisely in each instance with respect to either
