Hi John and Happy New Year,

I may have asked you this before but can you take a look at the attached and let me know if you have anything on any of these 3 Winn brothers (Galanus or Galaness, James and Joseph)?

It states that Galanus was from Lunenburg County VA and I have some notes that show he was later in Laurens SC. They must be related to the Winnsboro SC family but I can't find anything on Galanus - James and Joseph could be several different men but there should be something on Joseph since he was probably a Lt. or higher.

This is of interest to me because his son, Galanus, Jr. (born abt. 1813) is listed as a close neighbor of my 3rd great grandfather in Paulding County GA on the 1870 census.
