

MINOR WINN

2nd generation,  
MINOR WINN (2) 1704/1709--1778/1779 of Edgehill Plantation who was in the Parish of St. Margaret's, Caroline County, VA but not born there. He moved from Caroline County to Fauquier Co, VA. He went twice to Kentucky and bought land in Fayette County, Kentucky, but he lived and died in Virginia. He married MARGARET O'CONNOR, an Irish woman. Minor Winn's will is dated 1 July 1775, Will Book 1, p. 343.

JOHN D. WINN, son of Minor Winn & Mary Evans  
born Winnsboro, SC about 15 March 1791  
married/1 MARY SHANNON  
married/2 Anne McCaule (no children by her)

"His mother appears not to have approved of his move from Winnsboro, SC to Camden, SC prior to 1824 where he engaged in merchantile business, and she writes "had rather you had gone to some of those new counties, tho so far from me (probably meaning counties in western Georgia which were being opened about that time and to which his brother GEORGE WINN had moved), than settle in such a sickly place as Camden. He remained in Camden until 1835, and moved to Macon (Georgia-msw) in early 1835 again in mercantile business. He was among the first Commissioners appointed by the City Council to control Rose Hill Cemetery in 1839. After a few years he moved to Perry, Georgia, acquiring a plantation some three miles west of town and other property. Here he lived the remainder of his life. He was a Justice of the Inferior Court of Houston County, GA from 1853 to 1861. He died about 1863, aged 72.

DAVID REED EVANS WINN, born Camden, SC sometime about 1831  
He married, age 25, in 1856, and died age 32 in Pennsylvania  
in the Civil War.

He was a Doctor and practiced some with his uncle, DR. GEORGE A. WINN of Bolingbrooke, Monroe Co, GA. David Reed Evans Winn later moved to Americus, GA. He married 7 December 1856 to FRANCES MARY DEAN, daughter of James Dean of Macon, GA and his 2nd wife, Obedience Pearl Low. James Dean was a prominent banker in Macon, GA. His home was Vineville, suburb of Macon. FRANCES MARY DEAN had several sisters and half-sisters, one of whom, Henrietta Dean married first General William Holt and the 2nd time to Justice L. Q. C. Lamar.
