

Frame 412 - 1825 #18 - Petition for Guardianship - Filed June 17, 1825
John Yonque appointed guardian of Elieher Coleman, age 6, John was Elieher's stepfather. Mother, Mary Coleman had died.

Frame 422 has a plat of the land in dispute.

Frame 424 - 1825 #19 - Petition for Increase in Allowance
William S. Lyles guardian of Esther Woodward petitioned the court to increase allowance for Esther's education. Esther's guardian was changed from P. E. Pearson to William S. Lyles.

Frame 427 - 1825 #20 - Petition for Guardianship

George McCants brother of Elizabeth S. McCants, above 14 was appointed her guardian.

Frame 428 - 1825 #21 - Petition - Filed September 14, 1825

Jephthah Pickett and John B. Pickett filed a statement about the health of Musco Boulware. They were son-in-laws of Musco and wanted to handle his estate.

Ben Nettles

vs.

Thoret Eikin

Zachariah Nettles-died on August 31, 1820

John H. Nettles-son-died on January 1, 1819 on the way to Tennessee

Levicia Nettles-widow-latter married Thoret Eikin

John H. Nettles-son-moved to Alabama around the last of December 1824

William Nettles-son

Mary Nettles-daughter-died in 1819 or 1820-married (1) John Boatwright, (2) a Todd-lived in Georgia after 2nd husband died she returned to South Carolina-moved to Tennessee in 1816 or 1817 and married (3) John Campbell

Frame 34 - 1826 #2 - Bill for Injunction, Accounts and Relief - Filed September 25, 1824

Jane McKenna and David Aiken

vs.

Elizabeth M. Russell and Archibald Beaty

John Russell-lived in Kershaw County-died on July 6, 1817

Jane Russell-widow-latter married Patrick McKenna

William A. Russell-son-died in May 1822-married an Elizabeth.
