

Frame 363 – 1853 #12 – Petition for Guardianship – Filed June 7, 1853

John W. Rabb appointed guardian of Nancy Woodward-3.

Father-Joseph J. Woodward-died in April 1852.

Mother-Sarah M. Woodward

Frame 366 – 1853 #13 – Petition for guardianship

William B. Woodward appointed guardian of Edward P. M. Robinson-age 17 and Cassandria H. Robinson-age 15.

Father-John A. Robinson died in 1851

Their first guardian, James B. Mobly was their guardian had died, he was their uncle.

William B. Woodward was their half-brother.

Frame 369 – 1853 #14 – Petition to Change Trust Estate – Filed June 17, 1853

Jacob Gibson-died in 1851

Cynthia C. Gibson-daughter-married William J. Shelton

James L. Stewart was Cynthia's trustee.

Frame 374 – 1853 #15 – Petition for Sale of Property – Filed June 10, 1853

John McCrorey was the guardian of Bunyan Gladdney and Amos Gladdney.

Father-Joseph J. Gladdney-deceased

Frame 383 – 1853 #19 – Petition for Sale and Release of Trust Property – Filed July 11, 1853

Christina W. Faust divorced Clement C. Faust and moved to DeKalb County, Georgia.

Father-William Bratton

Brother-William W. Bratton.

Frame 394 – 1853 #20 – Petition to have Funds Paid – Filed July 11, 1853

Thomas Starke, Sr. petitioned to have Thomas J. Starke pay debts.

Frame 398 – 1853 #21 – Petition for Sale of Land – Filed July 6, 1853

John Thompson wanted to sell some lands of Mary Thompson, a lunatic.

Frame 402 has a plat of the property.

Frame 405 – 1853 #23 – Petition for Application of Funds – March 23, 1853

Alexander Young of Kershaw County administrator of Archelans Watson wanted to use proceeds of estate to pay creditors of Thomas J. Starke.
