1. Thomas Woodward
The Regulator
Killed by British and Tories
May 12, 1779
2. Sacred to the memory of Harriet (nee Smart) Woodward, wife of William T. Woodward, who died May 12, 1837 - about 30 years of age. (Vault)
3. John Woodward Durham, who died January 20, 1858, in the 51st year of his age.
4. William T. Woodward, Born 1792 - Died August 15, 1842 (Vault)
5. Mary A. C. (Ann Collins) Woodward - Born May 9, 1831 - Died June 9, 1845. (Vault)
6. Alva Milton Augustus, son of O. and M. (Osmond and Martha) Woodward
Died Nov. 20, 1835 - aged 8 yrs., 3 mos., and 11 days. (Vault)
7. Leonard Cornelia, daughter of O. and M. (Osmond and Martha Williamson) Woodward/
Died Dec. 6, 1832 - aged 3 yrs., 3 mos., and 17 days. (Vault)
8. William Strother, son of O. and M. (Osmond and Martha Williamson) Woodward
Died Octo. 16, 1823 - aged 3 mos. and 19 days.
9. John Osmond, son of O. and M. (Osmond and Martha Williamson) Woodward
Died Dec. 7, 1823 - aged 3 yrs., 5 mos., and 3 days. (Vault)
10. Lilla Rabb Gadsden - January 3, 1873 - July 30, 1962
11. Francis Marion Gadsden - April 24, 1861 - February 23, 1928
12. Christopher E. Gadsden - July 15, 1829 - June 15, 1864
13. Regina G. B. Gadsden - October 20, 1836 - February 23, 1891
14. John C. Gadsden - May 30, 1859 - January 22, 1898.
15. Martha Ann - Daughter of Christopher E. and Regina Gadsden
Died October 31, 1858 - aged 6 yrs., 8 mos., and 19 days.
16. Two vaults with tops completely gone. Must have been John Woodward
& (son of The Regulator) and his wife Estha McDonald Woodward, as they
17. were buried here also.
18. Sacred to the memory of Caroline Krumb - Formerly an inmate of the Orphan
House, Charleston, S. C. Departed this life May 4, 1819.
"What may be my future lot,
Well I know concerns me not,
This should set my heart at rest
What Thy will ordain is best."
19. One child's vault - Inscription slab gone.
20. Martha Ann - daughter of C. E. and Regina Gadsden. Died October 31,
1858 - aged 3 years, 8 months, and 19 days.
