ing one hundred acres situate lying & being in the County of Fairfax afores^t on the North side
of Sandy run being part containing four hundred & twenty three acres herein up to plantation
by Thomas Simpson deceased & settled & bequeathed by the said Thomas Simpson to his Daughter
Mary Woodward who is now espoused to the said John Robertson & the heirs of her Body together
with all houses Edifices Buildings Yards Gardens Orchards woods underwoods trees ways waters
watercourses Ponds Commodities Hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land &
Premises hereby bargained & sold belonging or in any wise appertaining to the Recession and
Reversion remainder & remainders thereon & Peculiarty thereof to have and to
Hold the said Land & Premises heron before mentioned as afores^t bargained &
sold & every part & parcel thereof with their & every of their appurtenances unto the s^rd John Robertson
his Ex^r Adm^r or designe from the day next before the day of the date hereof for & during & unto
the full end & term of one whole Year from thence next ensuing & failing to be completed & paid
yieling & paying therfrom the rent of one Cor of Indian Corn upon the last Day of the said term

authority to grant & bargain well & often release & confirm the same unto the said John Robertson
in manner & form aforesaid & also that he the said John Robertson his heirs & Assigns shall &
may from time to time & at all times hereafter peaceably & quietly have hold & occupy & possess
& enjoy the said Land & Premises hereby granted & released with their & every of their appurte-
nances without the Lawfull Sett & trouble. Notwithstanding hindrance Interruption of him
the said Thomas Woodward or of any other Person or Persons whatsoever & that he & clear & freely
& clearly acquitted & discharged of him & against all former & other gifts grants bargains
sales leases jointures Dowers Mortgages leases troubles charges & encumbrances whatsoever
had made committed done or suffered by him the said Thomas Woodward or any other Person or
Persons whatsoever the Just rents & values due & payable for the same being only ac-
cepted & forgoed Likewise that he the said Thomas Woodward & his heirs & all other Persons
lawfully claiming or to claim any Estate right title or Interest of us to the Premises or any
part or parcel thereof by him or under him than in any of them shall & will from hence to time to
all times hereafter upon the reasonable request & at the proper cost & charges of the said John Robertson
his heirs or Assigns make & execute & acknowledge all such further & other Lawfull & reasonable
Act & Acts thing & things conveyances & Assurances in the law whatsoever for the further
