In the Name of God Amen I William Wylie of Chester County & State of South Carolina being perfect helth & in perfect minde & memory Do make this my Last Will & testament & first of all I Give & Recomend my Soul to God that Give it & my Body to be Buried in A Decent Christian manner-----

Item I Will that my funneral Expence & all my Lawf Debts be paid-----Item I will & bequeath unto my Loving wife Margret Wylie Her Bed & furniture & one third of the household furnitur & my Sorrel gear & her own Side Saddle & two milk Cows & one Beef Steear----Item I will & Bequeath to my Son James Wylie two pounds fifteen ~~Shillings~~ Strl, which is the Remainder of one hunder Acres of the plantation he now Lives on which I paid for him-----Item I will & Bequeath unto my Son Joseph Wylie one Hunder acres of the plantation I now Live on to be laid oof on the South Side of Said Plantation Bounding on James Lusks Land----- Item I Will & bequeath unto my Son William Wylie one hunder acres of Said plantation to be Laid oof on the South Side of the South fork of the Creek that Runs thorow Said Said plantation B unding on George Allens Land but I will that he pay ten pounds Strl to those That I Shall Direct----Item I will & Bequeath unto my Son Thomas

which I paid for him-----Item I will & Bequeath unto my Son Joseph Wylie one Hunder acres of the plantation I now Live on to be laid oof on the South Side of Said Plantation Bounding on James Lusks Land----- Item I will & bequeath unto my Son William Wylie one hunder acres of Said plantation to be laid oof on the South Side of the South fork of the Creek that, Runs thorow Said Said plantation B ounding on George Allens Land but I will ~~that he~~ pay ten pounds Strl to those That I Shall Direct----Item I will & Bequeath unto my Son Thomas Wylie the Remainder of Said plantation ~~Except~~ the Dweling hous I will that my Loving Wife Have the Benefits of it & A Reason-able suport upon Said plantation as Long-as She Remains A Widow if She Never marrieth Duering her Naturel Life & at her Deceas or End of hir Wid hood then Said thomas Wylie for to have full possion of it & I will unto Said thomas Wylie one horse & Saddle-----Item I will & Bequeath unto my Son Samal Wylie one horse & Saddle & that hunder acres that I formerly Did Live on Bounding on the North Side of William McHullono Land Item I will & Bequesath unto my Daughter Elizabeth

Kenmore fourteen Shillings Strl-----Item I will & Bequeath  
unto my two Daughters Margret & Marey Wylie the Remainder of  
my Estate Goods & Chatties to be Equally/ Betwixt them

Item I will that the ten pound that/ to Comes from my Son  
William Wylie is to be taken for the use of Defraing my funner-  
al Expence & my Lawfull Debts & the Remainder to be Given to  
my two Duaghters Margret & Marey Wylie-----Item I ordain &  
appoint James Greer & James Dun to be my Lawfull Executors of  
this my Last will & testapent Renouncing & making Void all  
other wills heretofore made by me In wittness whereof I have  
hereunto Set my hand & Seal this fourth Day of December in the  
Year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & Ninty Nine-----
