Enclosed is a Grave Marker for JESSIE HAVIS (1764-1827).

In 1998 Ed Arnette walked me to the sight of Jessie's original burial site and at that time we agreed to try and have a marker installed. It was after Ed died that I was able to get the Veterans Administration to furnish this marker. I intended to put the marker in place but age has taken me over and I now realize that I will not be able to do it. So I am passing the chore to someone else, maybe you can find.

The grave site is located off of Highway 200 near the address of 2195 Highway 200.

The GPS location is as follows: N 34 24.094-W 81 03.576. If you go online at Boulder.com/gps/ an arrow will display the location on a map. At utility pole #1872 go about 100-200 paces perpendicular to highway 200 and it should be close by. This location confirms a note written by Mrs. Arnette stating that she could "see Jessie's grave site from her house" There is a big tree growing out of the grave site.

In the 1990s my son and I "cleared off" the site and attempted to reconstruct it with the bricks left when the slab was moved.

I may have some pictures and if I can find them I will enclose.

I hope you can find someone to finish this project.

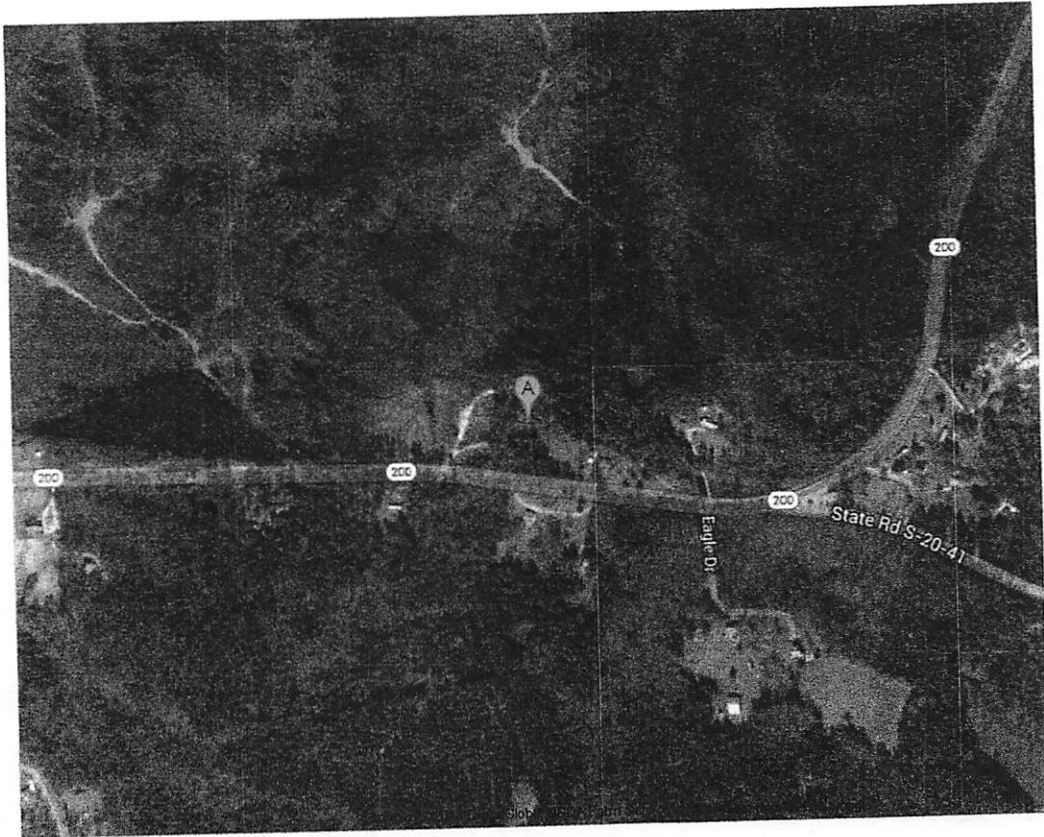

I am working on the Davis material. I copied some of it yesterday. But I am hunting for some items to add to it.

During Christmas, I wanted the house to look neat; I put some things away. Now, I am having a great time trying to find them.

At this point, one of our bed-rooms is strewn with papers. The digging will continue until I find what I am looking for.

I want to tell you - one time Ed Arnett's wife told me, that they had discovered a picture of Jesse Davis. I began thinking of the time period. Jesse died in 1827. That was a little early for daguerrotypes. I mentioned this to her and they decided it was Jesse's brother, John. I offered to pay for having the picture copied. Nothing more was said about it. Recently, I asked Ed about it. He said it is on the wall in his house, and he added "The scene isn't pretty!"

If you see Ed again, take a look at this picture. If you have a good camera and enough light with no glare, maybe you can copy it.

The location of Jesse's grave puzzles me. Once, they sent me a picture of Ed at the grave. It looked like it was in a thicket or grove of trees. They said the coping around the grave was bad. Ed's wife said she could look out her window and see the grave. I thought it was next to Ed's property.
