WAR OF 1812, SIZE OF ARMY

Third Auditor's Office, Aug. 13, 1840.

The army during the late war was composed of one regiment of light artillery, two regiments of dragoons, three regiments of heavy artillery, 46 regts. of infantry, and 4 regts. of riflemen, viz.:
