Enlisted August 20, 61 for the war by H. C. Davis at Ridgeway Depot Fairfield District.

Jan-Feb 62 elected 1st Lt.

April 62 present

Oct 62 present regt near Berryville

Nov-Dec 62 signed roll comdg company

Jan-Feb 63 present

Mar-Apr 63 present Captain

May-June 63 present

July-Aug 63 wounded and left at Gettysburg, Pa.

Jully 63 sent to DeCamp Gen hosp, David's Island, NY Harbor; transferred to Pt Lookout Apl 22, 64.

Nov-Dec 63 -

Jan-Feb 64 "in the hands of the enemy"

Mar-Apr 64 " " " " "

May 1 - Aug 31, 64 wounded furlough

Sept-oct 64 "wounded & furloughed home. Retired papers sent forward. Lost a leg at Gettysburg 1 July 63.

Furloughed by Med Ex Bd 1 April 64 and extended by Med Ex Bd, Columbia, S. C. to present date."

Nov-Dec 64 permanently disabled and retired.

There are two 63 Hinnant requisitions not transcribed. Did not seem useful.

James and John not transcribed as of 10-3-01.

Private James Reuben Richardson, KIA Sharpsburg, age 28. [BF, A&H card file]

Private John Samuel Richardson, DOW Gaines Mill, June 27, 1862 age 22. [BF, A&H card file]

Private Thomas Lewis Richardson, born 11-26-1834, age 27 [card file a&h]

Believe him to be same as Thos S. [S & L very similar in old hand] Richardson who enlisted April 13, 1862 at Ridgeway by Lt. Hinnant.

July-Aug 63 absent furloughed home on surgeon's certificate.

Sept-Oct 63 on detached service

Nov-Dec 63 " " " [believe at home recruiting/recovering]

Jan-Dec all reports present.

Paroled Appomattox April 9, 1865.

Private William Donald Richardson, age 17 March 18, 1862 at Ridgeway by Lt. John A. Hinnant. [so why is he in different jacket?]

July -Aug 62 'charged with one bayonet"

May 1 - Aug 31, 1864 absent on wounded furlough

Sept Oct 64 absent in Gen Hosp Columbia, S. C. Admitted Aug 64.

Nov Dec 64 absent "wounded near Ridley's Shop, 13 June 1864."

Paroled at Appomattox April 9, 1865.
