

PROCLAMATION BY GOVERNOR HARLEY

WHEREAS, The United States Army desires to acquire, for a five year period, "maneuver rights", to be available by April 1, 1942, in the following counties: Kershaw, Richland, Lexington, Fairfield, Chester, Union, Laurens, Newberry, Lancaster, Clarendon and Sumter, and

WHEREAS, The citizens and property owners of the State, residing within the above mentioned Counties have an opportunity to perform a patriotic service and aid in National Defense.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. Emile Harley, as Governor of the State of South Carolina, do hereby call upon and request all citizens of this State, and especially those residing within the counties in which the maneuvers are to take place, to assist in every way possible in acquiring the desired and necessary territory.
