Died January 1944; Reported Missing in Action, January 2, 1944, at Guadalcanal, Declared Dead January 14, 1946

Distinguished Flying Cross with two Gold Stars, Air Medal

MOORE, William L.

Private First Class, US Army

Died of Disease, Non-battle Injury, January 12, 1944; shot while attempting to escape from Osaka Main Prisoner of War Camp, Honshu Island, Japan

Finding of Death, No Body Recovered, February 14, 1944, at Carthage, Tunisia, North Africa

Killed in Action, June 7, 1944, at Omaha Beach, Normandy, France

AIKEN, David Edgar, Jr.

Born June 28, 1921

Second Lieutenant, US Army (38th Infantry, 2nd Division)

Killed in Action, June 13, 1944, in France

Buried at Salem Presbyterian Church Cemetery, Strother

Private First Class, US Army

Killed in Action, June 13, 1944, Normandy Beachhead, France

Buried at Florence National Cemetery, Florence

ELLENBURG, Henry E.

Killed in Action, June 14, 1944, during the invasion of France

Second Lieutenant, US Army Air Forces (524th Squadron, 8th Air Force; bombardier on B-17 "Flying Fortress")

Finding of Death, No Body Recovered, July 7, 1944; reported Missing in Action on bombing mission, near Leipzig, Germany

Killed in Action, April 23, 1945, near Wallmitshafen, Germany
Buried at Netherlands American Cemetery, Margraten, Netherlands
Purple Heart with Oak Leaf Cluster, Bronze Star, Silver Star

HEUSTESS, Joseph Alexander, Jr.
Born December 28, 1922
Tec Sergeant, US Army Air Forces (Turret-gunner on B-17 "Flying Fortress")
Killed in Action, April 26, 1945, over Czechoslovakia
Buried at First Methodist Church Cemetery, Winnsboro, date unknown

Private First Class, US Army
Died of Wounds, April 27, 1945, Okinawa
Buried at Salem Presbyterian Church Cemetery, February 1949
