MEETING HIGHLIGHTS October 09 2016

The Colleton Genealogy Society was called to order.

The next meeting will be Nov 13th Matthew Hiott will speak on the Historic Exchange Building located in Charleston, SC

Dot Glover was our guest speaker her topic Captain Joseph Glover, Revolutionary War Patriot, Prisoner, and Founder of the Walterboro Glover Clan.

Joseph Glover born Aug 28 1754 at Bluefield Plantation, St. Bartholomew Parish, Colleton County, SC. He died Apr 08 1806 Blythe Haven Plantation in Colleton County, SC from a fall from his horse. He was the son of Joseph Glover and Anne Wilson. Joseph Glover was a captain of the 3rd Company, Round O District. His father, Col Glover was commander of the Colleton Regiment of Foot appointed by Henry Laurens to oversee gunpowder supplies for the Colleton District militia and given command of Ft. Dorchester in 1775 to relieve Lt. Col. Elliott who had become ill. Capt Joseph Glover was one of the 130 militia officers taken prisoner by the British at the fall of Charleston. They were imprisoned aboard the ship "Torbay".

Capt. Joseph Glover married 1st to Anne D'Oyley, daughter of Col. Daniel D'Oyley and Ann Pinckney on May 01 1777 and became parents of Joseph Glover (1778 – 1819), Who became Dr. Joseph Glover Surgeon General of South Carolina.

Capt. Joseph Glover married 2nd Elizabeth Jeanerette (1768-Mar 12 1785) on Apr 15 1784. She was the daughter of Jacob Jeanerette of Santee. Elizabeth Jeanerette Glover died in childbirth.

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

After the death of Elizabeth, Capt. Joseph Glover married a third time to Jane Sinkler on Sep 13 1786 at Lifeland Plantation in St. Stephens Parish. She was the daughter of Peter Sinkler and Elizabeth Mouzon. Joseph and Jane had six children: James Sinkler Glover, Henry Charles Glover, Elizabeth Margaret Glover, Peter Sinkler Glover, Moses Wilson Glover and Jane Mary Glover. Meeting Adjourned.

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS Nov 13 2016

The Colleton Genealogy Society was called to order by Joyce Breland, Pres.

Treasurer's Report given and approved.

Larry Ulmer reported on the digitizing of school annuals which now totals 290.

Bill Corbin, a visitor, reported on his research on the Carter Family in Colleton County. He requested that anyone with any information contact him.

Joyce Breland introduced the speaker of the day, Matthew Hiott. Mr. Hiott has a degree in History. His topic was "A Brief History of the Old Exchange Building in Charleston, SC.

Construction of the Old Exchange Building started in 1768. In 1774 it was the largest building in Charleston.

It was a symbol of wealth.

In 1773 the building's basement was used to store 273 chests of tea. This tea was sold to help finance the Revolution.

The Old Exchange Building served in various capacities, as a storage area for gunpowder also used in the Revolution, goods, and a prison. Slaves were sold outside.

On August 08 1781 Colonel Isaac Hayne was executed. His last days were spent as a prisoner of the British in the Old Exchange Building.

In 1818 the Exchange Building was sold to the Federal Government and made into a post office.

In 1981 it was opened for tours.
