FORWARD

Small family burying grounds in the rural South grew out of necessity. Distances to churches and lack of transportation caused families living in the area to set aside a small plot for the burial of loved ones. With the decline of the family and the migration of the people to more populated areas, many of these small cemeteries were abandoned.

My interest in old cemeteries began as a child. My father was a stonecutter and loved to visit them and admire the work of the early craftsmen. He would point out the intricate work of the early stonecutters. After a tour in the Navy during World War II, I graduated with a degree in Mortuary Science and became a licensed embalmer and funeral director. This work carried me back to many of the small cemeteries in the area.

A long time friend and neighbor, Mrs. John B. (Cleora) Hall was interested in genealogical research. Often she would ask my wife, Frances Stewart Rutland, and me to accompany her to little known cemeteries in search for information. As more and more of the family farms were being sold to large timber companies, we realized that these small cemeteries were being lost to time. We began to copy all the tombstones and to identify the area where the cemeteries were located.

Since the death of Mrs. Hall in 1978, my wife and I have continued to search and record all that we can find. Countless hours have been spent these thirty or more years of searching, recording, returning several times to check and recheck the data. The work is far from finished, but the time has come to record in a more permanent way what we have done.

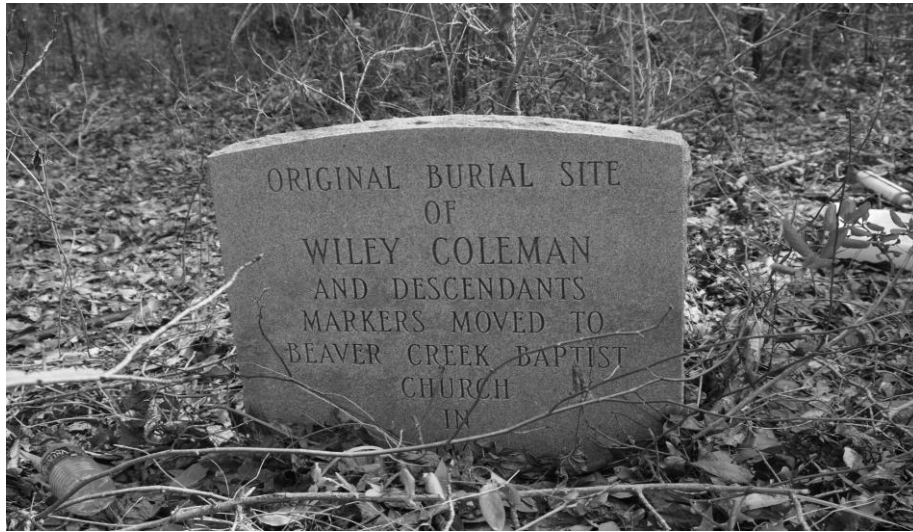

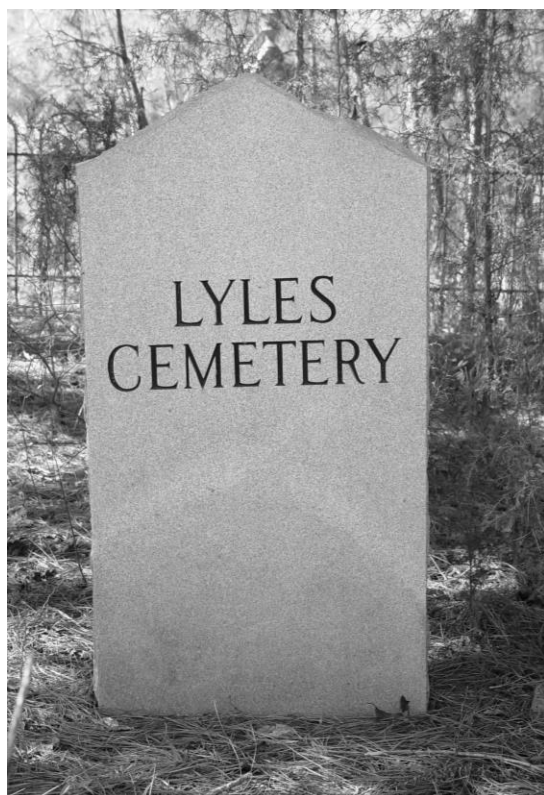

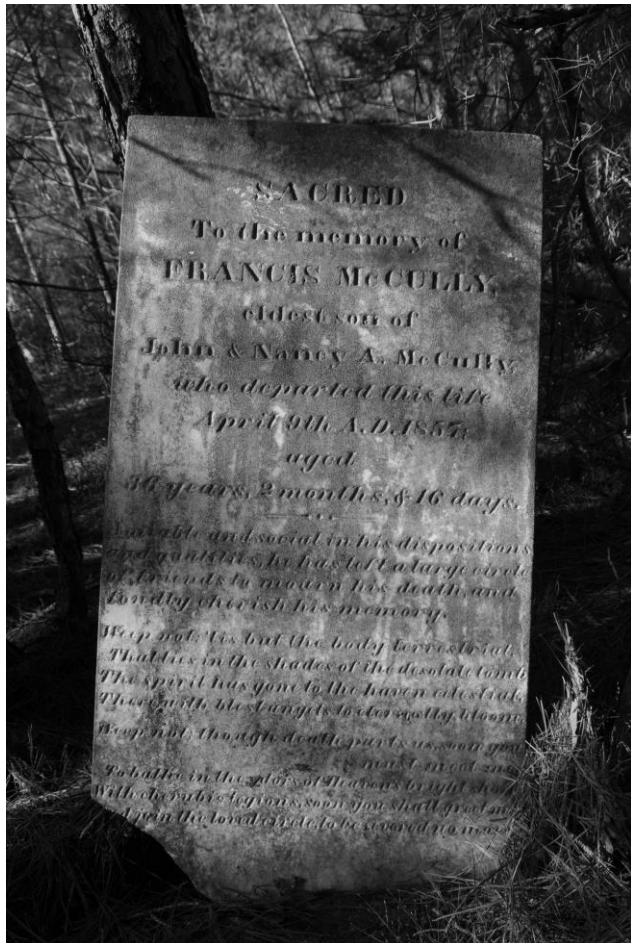
