## Coat of Arms of the Meador Family

A coat of arms is a design emblazoned on the shield of a warrior knight in the days of chivalry and usually continued in use through the years by his descendants. Only members of the royal family, of the nobility, or persons who have made some outstanding contribution to their country are granted permission to have a coat of arms, and descendants of such persons may use them as a family inheritance. Using a coat of arms without the authority of the Herald's College of Arms is a serious breach.

There is a Meador coat of arms which is said to have originated at Wytnesham, Norfolk County, England in 1188. Several years ago a color print was obtainable from the Meador Publishing Company of Boston, Massachusetts, but the firm is no longer in existence.

The Meador coat of arms consists of a shield, sable (black) with a chevron, azure (blue). The shield, called the field, is in three sections. On two of these is placed a pelican plucking its breast with its beak leaving a spot of red (gules). This bird, wounding herself to give food for her young, symbolizes love and self-sacrifice. On the third section of the shield is a lion statant (standing) peaceful but watchful, guarding home and country.

Above the shield is the helmet, the form of which indicates the rank of the owner, and above the helmet is an eagle with outspread wings.

Beneath the shield on a scroll of red (gules) ribbon is the Meador motto, in Latin,

MEA DOS VIRTUS

In translation, it says "My dowry is virtue," or better still, integrity. The Latin word *virtus* meant all the true manly qualities, honor, courage, uprightness. Perhaps integrity expresses the true meaning better than any other English word. Ours is a motto every Meador should be proud to make his own.

# Grants to Virginia

*Meaders as Recorded in Land Office (State Capitol)*  
(1663)

To all etc. Whereas now know ye, that I the said Sir William Berkeley, Knight, Governor of Virginia, give and grant unto Thomas Meader, Three hundred and twenty acres of land, situated on the south side of Hoskins Creek towards the head thereof in the County of Rappahannock, and extendeth itself from a marked red oak standing in a small neck by the main run side of the creek aforesaid and nigh unto the plantation of John Gillet, thence by the said run side thirty two poles unto a marked oak on the westernmost point of the said neck, thence along the northermost side at Beaver Dam until you meet with a line of marked trees that leadeth unto a poplar by the edge of the said Dam forty-eight poles, thence with the said line South by West. Two hundred and seventy-two poles to marked pine on following Ground, thence East by South one hundred and twenty-five poles to a White Oak on the brow of a hill, thence East Northeast, twenty-eight poles to meet with the Westernmost line of marked trees belonging to John Gregory, which divides this land and the land of the said Gregory, thence Northeast down to Hoskins Creek aforesaid and so finally parallel with the said Creek, one hundred eighty-one poles unto the marked Red Oak first above mentioned. The said land being due unto the said Meader for Transportation of Seven Persons etc. To Have and To Hold & To be Held Yielding Pay & provided & Dated the second of June, one thousand, six hundred and sixty-three.

To all etc. now know ye, that I the said Sir William Berkeley, Knight, Governor of Virginia, give and grant unto Thomas Meader Orphan, four hundred and fifty acres of land in Lancaster County on the South side of the head of Hoskins Creek, beginning at a poplar standing by the side of a Beaver Dam near the Indian path and running South by West two hundred and fifty poles, thence parallel to the dam West by North four hundred and fifty poles to the dam to the first mentioned tree. The said land being first granted to Thomas Browning by patent, dated the thirteenth of November, one thousand, six hundred and fifty-seven and by him assigned to John Cooke and by

Cooke assigned to Thomas Meader, Deceased and by his will given to the said Thomas Meader etc. To Have and To Hold etc. To be Held etc. Yielding etc. Paying etc. Provided etc., Date the ninth of April, one thousand, six hundred and sixty-four. (1664-April)

It is the belief of genealogists that Thomas Meader, the orphan and Thomas Meader who received a grant of 320 acres of land were one and the same party. See Richmond Co., Va., D. B. 21, pg. 419, dated 1738, Wm. Meador and Frances, his wife, Also same county, D. B. 20, pg. 203, dated 21 Jan. 1734, Wm. Meador and Frances, his wife.

## *Rappa. County Records*

*(Abstract)*

This indenture made 7th day August Anno Domini 1679.

John Meador of Farnham Parrish, Rappa. Co. planter, of the one part, for two breeding mares—a certain parcel, tract or dividend of land as by a patent as doth more largely appear situated, lying & being in Rappa. Co, conveying by affirmation 370 acres of land, situated on the S. side of Hoskins Creek & extendeth itself from a marked red oak standing in neck by the main run side of the creek aforesaid and nigh unto a path goeth over said run unto the plantation of John Gillett hence by the run side of creek, 302 poles unto a marked oak Western side pointe of said neck—belonging to John Gregory—being 300 acres was granted by patent from under the name of Sir Wm. Berkeley anno 1663 unto Thomas Meader & father of the aforesaid John Meader. —whatever use as expresst to be granted in the patent to Thomas Meader, as aforesaid—I, John Meader and Elizabeth, my wife do ablige & acknowledge this deed in open Rappa Co.

Copy of Will of John Meador, Essex County, Virginia, Wills, Inventories, etc., No. 3, 1717-1722:

"In the name of God Amen I John Meador of Essex County being Sick and weak in body but of Sound and perfect memory blessed be God theairfore do make and ordaine this to be my last will and Testant. in manner and forme following first and prinsably: Commend my Sole into the hands of God that gaive it hoping by the meritorious deth and passion of my blessed Lord and Savier Jesus Christ to receive full pardon and forgiveness of all my Sins and offenses and a Joyfull resurrection at the last Day and my body Desintly to be buryed at the Descreshon of my Exrs heiarafter named and as for the worldly goods yt. God hearth givin me I give and bequeth in mainer and form following.

- "Item. I give to my Son Thomas Meador one Shilling.
- "Item. I give to my Dather Reachell Jordan one Shilling.
- "Item. I give to my Dather Elica. Armstrong one Shilling.
- "Item. I give to my Dather Dinah Tribille one Shilling.
- "Item. my desyor is that my five Sons Shall keep their one guns without apraysin.
- "Item. I give to my Dather Mary Meador one Gold ring.
- "Item. I give to my Son Jonas Meador a Small peice of Land Jneing upon Thomas Evinnes Land and runin up to the Church rode that gose from my house then up a Long the rode a Small Corse till it Comes to a vale that gose to ye branch so down the branch till it Comes to the forcke of the branch whaire itt begune and from the forcke to ye first begining and the rest of my Lands I give to my other foure Sons to be Equally Doved with all my housis and Orchits theairon belonging and I doe apint my two Sons Jobe Meador and Jason Meador my Lawfull Exectirss. Item. I give to my son Joshua Meador one Chists not to be appraised and the rest of my Esstaite to be Equally Doved amongst my Childorin and I Leave my two youngest Soncs to be at age at Seavinteen and I do Leave my Son Jonas Meador to Look after them for three years and that my will not to be in force till my Dececes as witness my hand and Seale the 17th day of october in 1721.

SARAH BAKER'S FATHER, CAPT. THOMAS BAKER CAME TO AMERICA FROM ENGLAND, SERVED IN THE REVOLUTION, AND AFTERWARD SETTLED IN SOUTH CAROLINA, AND BECAME A WEALTHY CITIZEN. HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE, AND MET HIS DEATH WHILE FIGHTING A DUEL WITH J. BROWN, A FELLOW COLLEAGUE."  
(ABOVE QUOTED FROM " HISTORY OF BENTON, WASH., CARROLL, MADISON, CRAWFORD, FRANKLIN & SEBASTIAN COUNTIES - 1889".)

(FOLLOWING QUOTED FROM "SOUTH CAROLINA LEGISLATORS" ) -

"THOMAS BAKER WAS A RESIDENT OF WINNSBORO IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY. REPRESENTING THE DISTRICT BETWEEN BROAD AND CATAWBA RIVERS, HE SERVED IN THE SIXTH (1785-1786) AND SEVENTH (1787-1788) GENERAL ASSEMBLIES. HE ALSO WAS A MEMBER OF THE MOUNT ZION SOCIETY (1783) AND A CAPTAIN IN THE MILITIA (1785-1789). HIS WIFE, SARAH, PREDECEASED HIM IN FEBRUARY, 1785. KNOWN AS A HOT, UNCONTROLLED CHARACTER, BAKER WAS ACCUSED IN 1788 OF VICIOUSLY ATTACKING WITHOUT PROVOCATION ONE JOHN HAVIS. THE FOLLOWING YEAR, HE CHALLENGED J. BROWN OF WINNSBORO TO A DUEL AFTER BROWN HAD SWORN OUT A PEACE BOND AGAINST HIM. ON MAY 28, 1789 AT A RACING GROUND IN CAMDEN, THE TWO MEN WITH PISTOLS AND KILLED ONE ANOTHER. THOMAS BAKER LEFT A SMALL ESTATE OF SEVEN SLAVES, LIVESTOCK, HOUSEHOLD FURNISHINGS, AND A FRENCH HORN."

QUOTING "EDINGTON'S HISTORY OF FAIRFIELD":

"AN INCIDENT WORTH MENTIONING IS AS FOLLOWS: ABOUT THE LATTER PART OF THE LAST CENTURY, A MAN NAMED BAKER HAD SEVERAL WAGONS RUNNING, PROBABLY TO CAMDEN, WHICH WAS THEN A CONSIDERABLE TOWN. BAKER GOT INTO A LAWSUIT AND EMPLOYED D. R. EVANS. THE OTHER PARTY EMPLOYED A LAWYER OF CAMDEN NAMED BROWN. BAKER LOST THE CASE AND WAS OFFENDED AT SOMETHING BROWN SAID, AND ON HIS PASSING OUT OF THE COURT HOUSE CURSED BROWN FOR A "DAMNED SADDLE-BAG LAWYER". BROWN, BEING A SMALL MAN, COULD NOT FIGHT BAKER, BUT ON GOING TO HIS TAVERN HE WROTE BAKER A CHALLENGE, WHICH WAS REFERRED TO HIM BY EVANS FOR ADVICE. EVANS TOLD HIM HE WOULD HAVE TO RETREAT OR GIVE BROWN THE SATISFACTION HE DEMANDED. BAKER WOULD HAVE PREFERRED A "FIST FIGHT", BUT FINALLY ACCEPTED THE CHALLENGE. THE DUEL TOOK PLACE AT ROCK CREEK SPRINGS. BOTH WERE KILLED AT THE FIRST FIRE. BAKER WAS BROUGHT UP AND BURIED ON HIS FARM, TWO MILES FROM WINNSBORO. BROWN WAS BURIED AT CAMDEN."

SON'S WIVES - CHATTIE ANN MOORE (CRITTIE), SUSANNA MOORE (SUSIE) AND LUCINDA MOORE (LUCY) WERE DAUGHTERS OF FRANCIS NATHANIEL (NATHAN) MOORE, THE SON OF THOMAS AND DELILA (WILLIAMS) MOORE, NATIVES OF SOUTH CAROLINA, WHO WENT TO TENNESSEE IN 1825 AND THE SAME YEAR SETTLED IN WHITLEY COUNTY, KY. "AND PURCHASED OF THE LITTLE ROCK & FORT SMITH RAILWAY A PORTION OF HIS PRESENT FARM, HIS DEED DATED SEPTEMBER 8, 1859, BEING THE FIRST ISSUED BY THEM. HE HAS SINCE ADDED TO HIS POSSESSIONS UNTIL NOW HE IS ONE OF THE LARGEST LAND HOLDERS IN THE COUNTY, OWNING 500 ACRES OF GOOD LAND, WHICH IS THE RESULT OF HIS INDUSTRY AND BUSINESS ABILITY. HE IS A REPUBLICAN NOW, BUT PREVIOUS TO THE WAR HE WAS A DEMOCRAT. HE IS A LEADER OF HIS PARTY IN THIS VICINITY, AND WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SIX YEARS HAS SERVED CONTINUOUSLY AS JUSTICE OF THE PEACE SINCE 1864. GEORGE WASHINGTON BAKER MEADORS SPENT HIS BOYHOOD NEAR THE CUMBERLAND RIVER AMONG THE KENTUCKY HILLS. HIS EDUCATION WAS LIMITED, AS HE ATTENDED SCHOOL BUT A FEW MONTHS. FROM 1847 UNTIL DISCHARGED AT LOUISVILLE, KY. IN JULY, 1848, HE SERVED UNDER GEN. SCOTT IN CO. "K", 3RD KENTUCKY VOLUNTEER INFANTRY, GOING FROM VERA CRUZ TO THE CITY OF MEXICO. HE WAS RUN OVER BY A WAGON (SEE SHEET # 13 CONTINUED)

AT THE LAST PLACE AND SEVERLY HURT. IN 1851, SUBJECTS MOVED TO CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS AND HOMESTEADED 40 ACRES, TO WHICH HE ADDED, UNTIL 1898 HE HAD 120 ACRES OF WELL IMPROVED LAND UPON WHICH, SINCE 1875 HE OPERATED A GOOD GIN AND CORN MILL, ALL HIS PROPERTY BEING THE RESULT OF HIS OWN PERSONAL EFFORT. HE WAS FORMERLY A DEMOCRAT, BUT SINCE "THE WAR" HAS BEEN A REPUBLICAN. FOR FIVE YEARS AFTER THE WAR, HE HELD A CAPTAIN'S COMMISSION IN THE MILITIA. MR AND MRS. MEADORS ARE MEMBERS OF THE MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH. IN 1898, IN CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THERE WERE 83 VOTERS DIRECTLY MEMBERS OF THIS FAMILY, AND OF THESE, 81 WERE REPUBLICAN."
