#### Introduction

This report is the result of the efforts of two family historians, working 50 years apart, researching their family ties to the Old Cam'nethan Kirkyard. In 1972, Andrew Brownlie completed what is, until this day, the most comprehensive survey of the monumental inscriptions at the Old Kirkyard of Cam'nethan. He donated a copy of his work to the Scottish Genealogical Society which had issued a call for all pre-1855 cemeteries to be recorded. Over a period of several days he recorded every extant marker, including those for his ancestral family: the Brownlies of Historic Garrion Mill.

Fifty years later in 2022, I was researching the Russell and McAlpine families of the 1800s in Netherton, Cambusnethan Parish, Lanarkshire. Internet searches led me to the 1972 Brownlie survey and, later, its author. The Scottish Genealogical Society sent a copy of the three page work. I had a family letter from 1844 saying that John Russell had died at Allanton House and was buried in the Old Cam'nethan Kirkyard and the 1857 death certificate of his wife Margaret McAlpine with the same burial location given. So I was very glad to find my family among the 64 monumental inscriptions as a confirmation of family lore. Reading further in the pages, I was amazed to see literally 100s of names listed as on the tombstones...what a genealogical treasure!

Mr. Brownlie, in our recent correspondence, has graciously allowed me the use in this report of the details of his 1972 work. He has also converted his 50 year old slides of the Burial Ground into digital images and contributed them to the project. All of his information is included in the pages that follow.

More recent internet searches led to finding, first, an additional listing of the tombstones done in 2011 and, second, a photographic assessment done in 2018. There were 42 legible tombstones in 2011, but less than 20 could be definitely transcribed from the 2018 photographs. Clearly, the decline in numbers of legible inscriptions indicates the danger that all will have disappeared in the future. And our photos show the same: We can see the decline though the "then and now" photos on the inside and outside of the back cover.

Mr. Brownlie joins me in the hope that this compilation of the family names and places mentioned on the tombstones will be of use to Lanarkshire historians and will also raise awareness among descendants and researchers of the need to protect and preserve this important historic landmark. We welcome your thoughts and comments on this work as well as additions and corrections for future revisions.

Grangeburn gives this complete transcription with no reference citation: Sacred to the memory of Charlotte S. Lockhart, second wife of Robert Lockhart, esq., who died at Ferneyside, Liberton, March 1859. A

search of Scotlandspeople does turn up a Death Certificate for Charlotte Lockhart, widow of Robert Lockhart, with death date as 18 March 1869 (not 1859). The death certificate does not indicate place of burial.

### Important notes for researchers

- 1. Proceed with Caution, please!! Every possible care has been taken to record each tombstone and archival detail correctly. However, there are many possibilities of error in typography, handwriting decipherment, and electronic transmission. In addition, it is sometimes difficult to sort out the family relationships listed on the tombstones. So before you include any detail in your family records, you should follow up and reconfirm in the source material whenever possible.
- 2. All dates have been converted to standard international genealogical format: e.g., 12 January 2022.
- 3 Every inscribed NAME has an entry number and is included in the index: Inscribed names are formatted in all caps for surname. In addition, names found in records or certificates are included in the index and are formatted with no caps for surname.
- 4. Women are, whenever possible, indexed by both their married and their maiden surname.
- 5 Place names are indexed separately.
- 6. Your input is encouraged!!! Please send additions and corrections to me at (judith.f.russell@gmail.com) so that they can be incorporated into a future updated document.

#### **Brief Historical Note and Locational Information**

Although our purpose in this report is to insure that the information inscribed on the Old Cambusnethan Kirkyard monuments is preserved, we also include here some starting points for further investigation into the Kirkyard's history and significance. There is a great deal of information online about the Burial Ground, especially in reference to the burial there in 1679 of the Covenanter, Arthur Inglis. There are also many photographs, including the ones at google maps, listed below. "The churchyard is the remains of the original Cambusnethan Parish Church founded by St Nethan in the 8th century. Later becoming St Michael's before the Reformation when the church was moved up to the village. It is close to the site of the original Cambusnethan House which belonged to the Baird family in the Medieval period, succeeding to the Stevensons (Lockhart of Castlehill) in the 17th century. The mausolea that have been built since the move up to the village in that century represent the estates that the original Cambusnethan Baird owned land was broken up into, ie Belhaven's of Wishaw, the Stewarts of Coltness and the Lockharts of Castlehill."


