This was the Bible of Thomas Furman Broom, M.D. (born March 7, 1834) and his wife Cecily Aline Coleman (born June 1, 1834), see chart below.

It was evidently given to their daughter (my great aunt) Lil who married John Murray Clements. They had one child to live -- Edith Clements who inherited this Bible. Edith married Martin Luther McNeill, Sr. This Bible was evidently given to their son, Joe Allen McNeill, since his widow Lillian gave it to me (James W. Green, III) about 5 years ago (i.e. about 1985). I too am a descendant of the original owners of this Bible -- Dr. T.F. Broom and Cecily -- thru their son Walter Furman Broom (born 1864) who had a daughter Essie I. Broom (born 1913) who is my mother.

Over the years, I have given several things (related to this Bible) to the S.Caroliniana Manuscript Room including a chart of William Broom's descendants and other Broom and Powell Bibles.

From when I was 1 until 22, I lived in Johnson City, TN 37601 at 614 Lamont St. On moving from there to the Broom land in Fairfield Co., SC, in March 1972, our address changed to Rt. 3, Box 44-i, Winnsboro, SC 29180. We have not moved since then, but the P.O. has changed our address to Rt. 4, Box 44HD and on Aug.27, 1988 it changed to Rt. 5, Box 720, which is my current address.

March 16, 1990, I made 2 color copies of the marriage page of this Bible. One for the South Caroliniana Library Manuscript Room's Bible Collection and one for the Fairfield County Museum Genealogy Room's Bible collection. Then yesterday, Tue. 20 March 1990, I took Caroliniana the color copy I made for them together with the duplexed title page and the duplexed Deaths/Family History sheet that I made for them. Then, I made for the Fairfield County Genealogy Room's Bible collection a duplex (2 sided) copy on acid free paper of both the Bible's title page (front and back) and a duplex copy of the Deaths/Family History sheet (front and back) which had never been filled out. The Births sheet is missing, so I could not copy it for the libraries. There are a lot of old photos (including over 6 tin types) loose in this Bible, but only one is identified. It says J.B. Broom. From the date on the label and the youthful appearance of the man shown, I wonder if this could be John Bunyan Broom Jr. or some other J. B. Broom rather than John Bunyan Broom born 1831.

I included a copy of this file in the xeroxes that I gave Caroliniana Mar. 20 then I modified the file and printed this sheet on acid free paper.

I intend to give this sheet and the xeroxes for the County Museum to the County Museum Genealogy Room by giving them to Mrs. Ruth Mason Stevenson (who works there) when I see her at the Fairfield Chapter SCGS meeting this Sunday 25 March 1990.

Embossed in gold leaf on the front cover of this Bible is "DR. T.F. BROWN". It should have been written "DR. T. F. BROOM".
