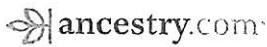




Fisher/Pisauro Family Tree

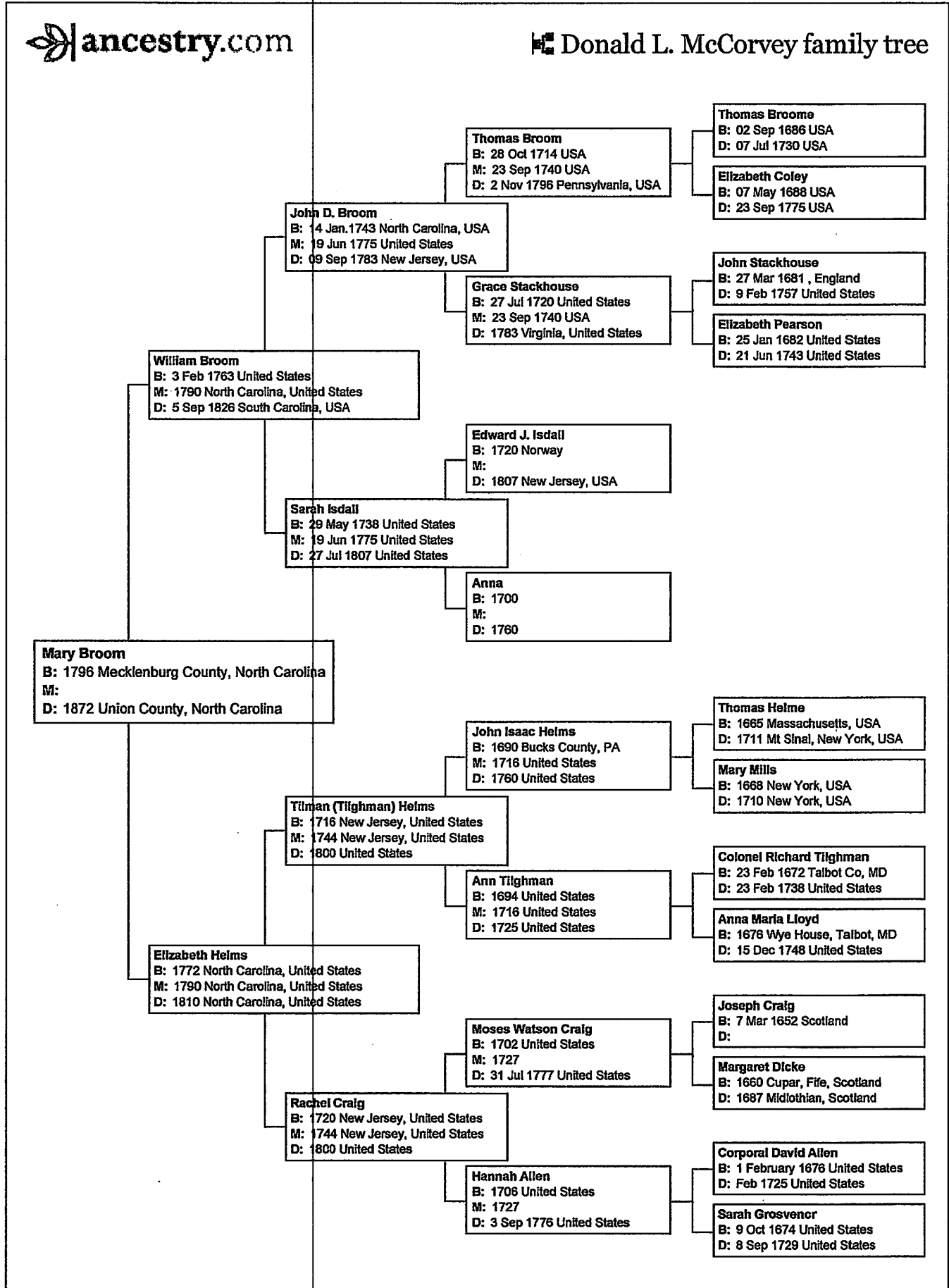

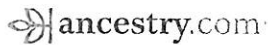

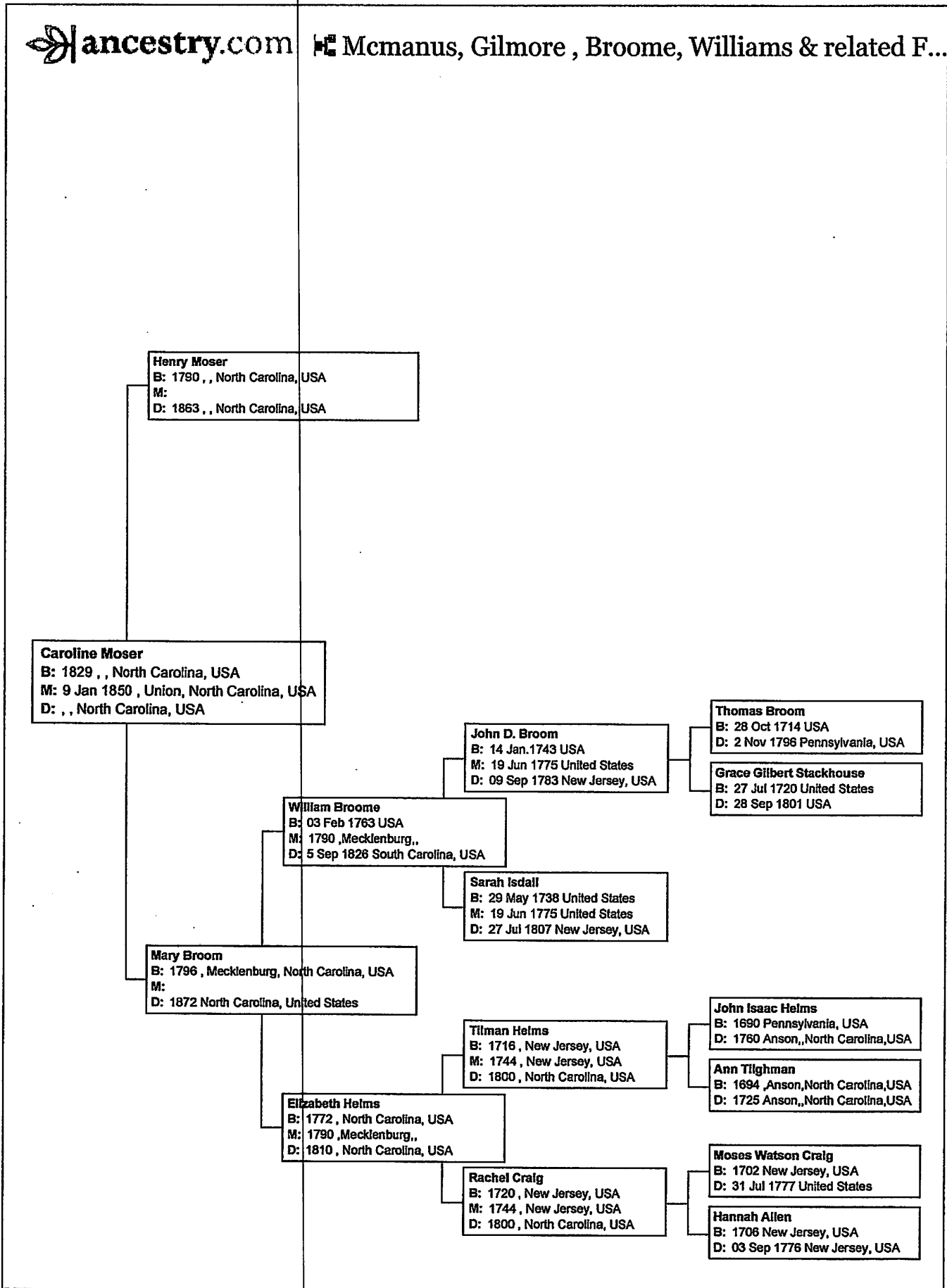

English/Scottish border near Hawick, where in 1366 members of the family name acquired lands. In this area, deep in the Teviot Hills, there is a Broomhouse and Broomfields, and the family is mentioned in the chronicles of the Border sagas. The family also had estates in Glasgow by the year 1550, and in the 1600's the name was reasonably popular in the city of Edinburgh. Meanwhile in England the name flourished in Norfolk, and from the entries in the census records, such as the Hundrendorum Rolls and the Pipe rolls, the Christian names popular with the Family Name were, William, Henry, Eustace, Nicholas, Roger and Robert, and all these names were registered at least once as holders of estates. One of the notable English dramatists of the Tudor-Stuart period, was Richard Brome, who wrote many satirical comedies of life in London in the 17th century. Outstanding amongst the family at this time was Henry Broome at the Battle of Bosworth.

The surname Broome Contributed much to local politics and in the affairs of England or Scotland. During the 12th century many of these Norman families moved north to Scotland. Later, in the 16th and 17th and 18th centuries England was ravaged by religious and political conflict. The Monarchy, the Church and Parliament fought for supremacy. The unrest caused many; to think of distant lands.

In Ireland, settlers became known as the "Adventurers for land in Ireland". They "undertook" to keep the Protestant faith, occupying the lands of the Irish. There is no record of this family migrating to Ireland, but this does not preclude the possibility of individual migration to that country.

The democratic way of life of the New World beckoned many. They sailed aboard the fleet of sailing ships known as the "White sails".

In North America, migrants which could be considered a kinsman of the family name Broom-e, or variable spellings of that same family name included Roger Broom-e who settled in Boston Mass, who sailed for America on the "Truelove" in September of 1635. Sarah and Francis Broom-e settled in Maryland in 1775; John Broom-e of Yorkshire, who settled in New York in 1732; John Broom passed through Virginia in the late 1740's, who many believe was the John Broom, son of Thomas Broom, of Delaware. He settled in the part of Mecklinburg Co. which later became Union Co. in N.C.; another John Broom settled in Jamaica in 1722; Daniel Broom settled in Philadelphia Pa. in 1683; the family also settled in California, New York, in the 18th and 19th centuries. From the port of arrival settlers joined the wagon trains westward.

Meanwhile, the family name was highly regarded in the social stream. There were many notables of this name, Broome Air Marshall Ivor Broome; and Judge F.N. Broome. Jacob Broom (1752-1810) an American statesman, was a signer of the United States Constitution (nephew of John Broom of N.C). He was the first postmaster of Wilmington, Del. He started the first cotton factory in Delaware, and built the first cotton mill in Brandywine in 1795. He sold the millsite in 1802 to Eleuthere I. du Pont. Du Pont erected a powder mill there. Jacob Broom was born in Wilmington, Del. Robert Broom (1866-1951) was a Scottish anatomist and paleontologist, discovered in South Africa the fossil remains of the various Australopithecus forms. He was born in Scotland, and was graduated from Glasgow University.

During the American War of Independence some declared their loyalty to the Crown and moved northward into Canada and became known as the united Empire Loyalists. While at the same time there was a Mason Broom, from N.C. who fought in The Revolutionary War; Allen Broom, son of John Broom, of Meck. Co. N.C., fought in the War of 1812; and many Sons of the South, who fought in the War Between the States(1861-1865). Some of those in particular, from N.C., were John Wesley Broom; Levi Broom; Corporal Squire Broom (Bodyguard for Major General Whiting; T M Broom; Ellerson Broom; William H. Broom; of whom many served in the "Monroe Heavy Artillery" Unit from Monroe N.C. There was also a Albert T. Broom; Calvin Broom; Jackson A. Broom; Nimrod Broom; Sampson Broom; Sampson A. Broom; Corporal Soloman Broom; Wilson B. Broom, and Francis Marion Broom; of N.C. Troops. We must also mention Col. John A. Broome of Lagrange Ga., son of Rufus Broom, son of Burrell Broom of N.C. These are just to name a few. Some were wounded, killed, captured or missing in action. And of course we can not leave out our own Great- Great Grandfather Abel Broom who died at 2nd Battle of Manassas, Va. Sept. 1862. His brother Wesley Broom served in the same Company E, 12 South Carolina Infantry.

A BREIF HISTORY OF OUR FAMILY AND THE NAME BROOM-E

The chronicles of England show the early records of the name Broom to be derived from the Norman race. Some sources also say that it is either a locational or a topographical surname. If the former, it derives from any one of the various places called Broom (in Bedfordshire, Durham and Worcestershire), Broome (Norfolk, Shropshire and Warwickshire), and Brome, in Suffolk. Most of the places are recorded in the Domesday Book of 1086 as "Brume" or "Brom", and all share the same meaning and derivation from the Olde English pre 7th Century word "brom", meaning (place of) broom or gorse. As a topographical surname Broome, Broom or Brome denotes residence near a place where broom grew. (Broom shrubs have green branches and are sometimes striped and almost without leaves. The yellow flowers are shaped like butterflies. The fruit is a pod with one or more seeds in it. The broom belongs to the pea family, Leguminosae.). The name appears in England from about 1066 A.D., and it's history is interwoven within the majestic tapestry which contains the history of Britain.

Professional researchers used such ancient manuscripts as the Domesday Book (compiled in 1086 by William the Conqueror), the Ragman Rolls, the Wace poem, the Honour Roll of the Battel Abbey, The Curia Regis, Pipe Rolls, the Falaise Roll, tax records, baptisms, family genealogies, and local parish and church records to establish that the first record of the name Broom or Broome was found in Dent where they had been granted lands by William the Conqueror for their assistance at the Battle of Hastings in 1066 A.D.

Broom or Broome, occurred in many references, but from time to time, spellings included Broom, Broome, Brome, Brume, or Brom. Scribes recorded and spelled the name as it sounded. It wasn't unlikely that a person would be born with one spelling, married with another, and buried with a headstone which showed another spelling.

The Normans were commonly believed to be of French origin but, more accurately they were of Viking origin. The Vikings landed in the Orkneys and Northern Scotland about the year 870 A.D., under their King, Stigurd the Stout. Later, under their Earl, Thorfinn Rollo, they invaded France about 910 A.D. The French King, Charles the Simple, after Rolo laid siege to Paris, finally conceded defeat and granted northern France to Rollo. Duke William who invaded and defeated England in 1066, was descended from the first Duke Rollo of Normandy.

The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of Robert De Brome, which was dated 1193, in the "Pipes Rolls of Leicestershire", during the reign of King Richard I, known as The Lionheart", 1189-1199.. Surnames became necessary when governments introduced personal taxation. In England this was known as Poll Tax. Throughout the centuries, surnames in every country have continued to "develop" often leading to astonishing variants of the original spelling.

The surname Broom-e emerged as a notable family name in the county of Kent. The family name claims direct descendancy from the Earls of Anjou who changed their name to Broom-e after a pilgrimage to the crusades and the Holy Land. Fulk, Earl of Anjou, having worn a sprig of Broom as a symbol of humility took the name of the plant as his name. Fulk was father of Geoffrey Plantagenet. This English royal house of Plantagenet received its name from the Latin term *Planta genista*, which means sprig of the broom plant. Another one of the first, on record, was Sir William de Broome, standard bearer to King Edward II of England. Thomas Brome was secretary to King Henry VI, and Henry Broome followed the Earl of Richmond and died in his cause at Bosworth. This family name claims direct descent from the Kings of England, from King Edward I, to be more precise, and family name historians have made representations to the crown for this recognition many times in the past. There is on file many gifts from various Kings and Queens. Queen Elizabeth the 1st sent a silver cup and fan; James I, a richly bound green satin Bible; and from King Charles 1st the proclamation forbidding that any of the family should be "vexed, hurt or molested". One of the records of this name was in the English county of Norfolk in the 13th century, but within a century the name appeared in Scotland, on the
