

Nurse killed in collision with big rig

A Hospice nurse on her way to see a patient Monday morning missed a stop sign and drove her gray Nissan Altima into a freight truck. She died of her injuries at the scene.

Rosalind Broome of Johnson Street in Winnsboro, was traveling northeast at 12:05 p.m. on Smallwood Road when she skidded through the stop sign at State Highway 34, driving into the side of a 52-foot freight truck traveling southeast. Broome's Nissan plunged under the truck and was run over by the back wheels. Broome was wearing a seat belt.
